Until the Farm Stand opens, you can still drop by the farm house to pick up meats, preserves, ferments and sweet potatoes.




## The Farm is Alive

This time of year is a particular favourite of ours, as we welcome new life to the farm. We've been very busy these past few weeks getting everything ready for our new layer chicks, and our new piglets. We didn't breed our sheep last fall, so we haven't had a gaggle of baby lambs to entertain us. That just means more loving for our latest newcomers!



In previous years we housed our baby layers in one of the barns until they were big enough to move to an outdoor pen. We decided to experiment this year. Since the chicks need heat lamps to keep warm, and since our greenhouse is usually too cool overnight for seedlings just yet, we decided to put the chicks in the greenhouse so their heat lamps would provide heat for the seedlings too. So far it's working, and we have been able to have the greenhouse in operation a good 2 to 3 weeks earlier than usual. BONUS!



This week we also welcomed 5 male piglets to the farm. Ned, Ted, Hank, Frank and Whitey are a constant source of entertainment. And not just for us .... the cat and dog love to sit and watch them too, but the chickens aren't quite sure yet!
